2. NEW MEMBERS (LEARN TO SKATE) REGISTRATION

NO MAIL-IN, E-MAILED OR FAXED REGISTRATIONS for new members. New members (including siblings of returning members & skaters who were members prior to 09/10 will register starting September 13, 2010 and will have 2 options, ON-LINE or IN-PERSON

- ◆ ON-LINE registration – follow on-line registration procedures. NOTE: new skaters registering before Sept. 13 will be denied.
- ◆ IN-PERSON registration is in the club office on: Sun-Fri from 5-7pm.

FEE PAYMENT PROCEDURES:

1. For ON-LINE Registrations – Follow on-line registration procedures
2. For MAIL-IN Registrations (returning members) – Payment by VISA, MASTERCARD, MONEY ORDER, CASH or CHEQUE ONLY
CHEQUES PAYMENTS: Payable to East York Skating Club
Option #1: Payment in full by cheque dated AUG 31st or Day of Registration
Option #2: Payment in 3 installments with post-dated cheques for: AUG 31st or Day of Registration, OCT 15th, NOV 30th
3. For In-Person Registration – Payment by CASH, CHEQUE, MONEY ORDER, VISA, MASTERCARD, or DEBIT. Payment by credit card or debit requires full payment. Payment by cheque can be made in installments (as above)

MUSIC OPERATORS & PROGRAM ASSISTANTS FOR 2010/2011

The club is looking for the 2010/2011 group of Music Operators & Program Assistants. If you are interested, please contact Diane Fukushima @ 416-759-0586, or @ dianefukushima@rogers.com by August 23RD.

The following are the requirements to be a Music Operator:

- Qualified for the C Session as of Spring 2010
- It is recommended that the skater be at least 11 years of age as of Sept 1st
- Call the coordinator to officially apply for the position
- Must attend the Music Orientation Meeting (See Below)
- Skater must sign a contract with the Club
- The skater will be remunerated by receiving \$5.00 / hour paid directly to the Skater & \$5.00 / hour as Skating Credits towards Membership Fees.
- Skater will be given an orientation regarding the operation and rules for the music room on Tuesday, Sept 7th, 2010 @ 7:15PM

Program Assistants (PA's) are a vital part of the CanSkate 1 & 2, and A Sessions. PA's are the higher-level skaters of the club who assist on the lower sessions, as well as partner skaters at the lower level test days. PA's must attend the seminar to be certified to PA in the winter. The following are the requirements for Program Assistants:

- Qualified for B Session as of Spring 2010
- It is recommended that the skater be 10 years old as of September 1st
- Contact coordinator to officially apply for the position
- Skater MUST ATTEND the PA Seminar on Sunday, September 12th, 2010 from 3:15 – 5:30 PM. SKATES ARE REQUIRED.
- Sign a contract outlining your responsibilities
- Receive a \$4.00 / hour credit towards their membership fees for the next season.

The coordinator will contact you prior to the start of the skating season to confirm your application.
