Important Procedures for Run-Throughs, Dress Rehearsal & Show Nights

[Run-Throughs - 1st Half: Monday, April 27 & 2nd Half: Tuesday, April 28 from 6-8 pm](#)

1ST HALF NUMBERS: Requiem for a Dream, Day Dream Believers, Sheep, Mr. Sandman, Sugar Plum Fairies, Dreamer, I Dream of Jeannie, Sweet Dreams, Dance Court

2ND HALF NUMBERS: Skeletons, Bats, Ghostbusters, Vampires, Beetle Juice, Witches, Ghosts, Zombies, Parade of Champions

- 1 Determine which half your skater is in
- 2 All Skaters to arrive at the arena **20min before 6 pm**
- 3 Skaters to sit in the seats according to their number
Signs will be posted on the glass in front of the seats
- 4 **SKATERS MUST HAVE THEIR GUARDS** since they will be sitting in the stands with their skates on
- 5 Skaters will be called as a group to perform their number (according to show order)
- 6 After the first performance the skaters are to return to their assigned seats
- 7 Each half will be performed at least two times
- 8 **SKATERS ARE NOT TO LEAVE UNTIL THEY ARE TOLD BY ONE OF THE COACHES ON ICE**

[Dress Rehearsal - Thursday, April 30 @ 6 pm](#)

- 1 Skaters should arrive at the arena by **5:30 pm**
- 2 Skaters are required to be in full costume and make-up
- 3 Skaters will be allowed to sit in the stands during dress rehearsal as a group
- 4 Parents will be permitted in the dressing room area on dress rehearsal if necessary
- 5 Grand finale will be practiced between the 1st and 2nd halves
- 6 Once your skater has finished their number and has been in grand finale they can leave

[Show Nights - Friday, May 1 @ 7:30 pm, Saturday, May 2 @ 1:30 pm & 7 pm](#)

- 1 All Skaters arrive at the arena 1 hour before each performance
- 2 Parents to drop-off & pick-up skaters by the south-east emergency exit door **ONLY!**
PARENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED IN THE DRESSING ROOM AREA (see below)
- 3 Skaters must stay in their dressing rooms
- 4 Skaters will not be permitted in the stands to watch the show
- 5 Skaters do not have to stay for grand finale
- 6 Skaters will not be able to access the stands or lobby from the dressing rooms
- 7 Parents will not be able to access the dressing rooms from the lobby or the stands
- 8 Arena will be closed between shows on Saturday. No one will be permitted to access arena.

PARENTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED IN THE DRESSING ROOM AREA

During Friday and Saturday shows parents will not be permitted in the dressing room area unless you are working as a volunteer in the dressing rooms. We ask the parents to drop off and pick up their skaters at the south-east emergency exit **ONLY**. There will be plenty of volunteers to take your skater to and from the correct dressing room. The reason we ask this is due to the sheer number of skaters we have in the show and the limited space we have to work with. There are approximately 300 skaters registered for this show. If your skater is only in the first half of the show and will not be participating in the grand finale, you may pick the skater up after the first half at intermission. If your skater is in the second half and does not wish to take part in the grand finale, you may pick them up after Closing Sequence (before Grand Finale). If your skater is taking part in the grand finale we ask that you take your time in picking up your skater so that it gives them time to change and the volunteers time to organize skaters for departure.

- 10 **MOST IMPORTANTLY:** If skaters leave to go and see the show they will need a ticket of their own & will not be permitted to return TO THE DRESSING ROOMS.

Skater Ice Show Attendance Requirements & Code of Conduct:

Skaters may not miss more than 1 on-ice practice and must attend all RunThroughs and Dress Rehearsal. Skaters are expected to follow the Club's Rules & Regulations (pg 22 of Brochure) and behave appropriately during all practices, run-throughs, dress rehearsal and show nights. Skaters are expected to treat coaches and volunteers with respect and dignity. Designated costumes and accessories are not to be altered in any way. Failure to comply may forfeit the skaters' position in the show.
